Most of us fail to manage our time effectively. There are lots of books about time management on the market, but you don't need to waste time (and money) reading them. Here are some tried and tested tips for getting things done.

Tip 1 : It's so easy to make excuses and find ways to avoid the thing you know you should be doing. Experts advise us to break this habit by becoming aware of our own excuses. The 'right time' to do something never arrives: the best time to do something is usually now. Once you've got started, you'll probably find that it wasn't as hard as you thought .

Tip 2 : It's important to make yourself a 'to do' list or exam revision timetable, but remember that listing things isn't the same as doing them (see Tip 1!). Once you've worked out what needs to be done, decide which tasks have the highest priority and which can be left till later.

Tip 3 : It's inevitable that things don't always go as well as you expect them to. If you find that you've 'hit a wall', there are two things you can do. First, persevere: with a bit more effort, you may find that you break through the wall. But if that doesn't work, try having a (short) break. Do something completely different, and come back to the task.

Tip 4 : Even if you're under stress, there's no point making yourself ill – that will just make the pressure worse. Make sure you remember to eat regularly and healthily, and, even though it may be hard, try to get enough sleep.

Tip 5 : You can't always make your brain work 'on demand'. Don't spend too long on one task, and learn to recognise when you're slowing down. Divide large tasks into smaller parts that are easier to manage, and reward yourself for completing them by doing something fun.

Most companies have their own websites ; others exist only on the internet . Despite all good things , internet addiction exists .

The latest addiction to trap thousands of people is the internet , which has been blamed for broken relationships , job losses , financial ruin and even suicide . Internet Addiction Syndrome (IAS) is a new illness that could cause serious problems and ruin many lives . Addicts have dreams about the internet ; they need to use it first thing in the morning ; they lie to their parents and partners about how much time they spend online ; they wish they could cut down , but are unable to do so . A young addict usually spends 40 hours a week on the internet . Most of the addicts are teenagers who are already hooked on computer games and who find it very difficult to resist the games on the internet .

Many people turn to the internet in order to manage unpleasant feelings such as stress , loneliness , depression and anxiety . When you have a bad day and are looking for a way to escape your problems or to quickly relieve stress , the internet can be an easily accessible outlet . Losing yourself online can temporarily make feelings such as loneliness , stress , anxiety , depression , and boredom evaporate into thin air . As much comfort as the internet can provide , though , it's important to remember that there are healthier (and more effective) ways to keep difficult feelings in check . These may include exercising , mediating , using sensory relaxation strategies , and practicing simple breathing exercises .
